Effective June 1, 2010 the Organization became the Principal Campaign Fund Organization (PCFO) for the Mountain State Combined Federal Campaign. Combined Federal Campaign (CFC) is the largest workplace charity program in the United States and the only campaign authorized to solicit and collect contributions from federal employees in the workplace on behalf of charitable organizations such as the United Way. The nationwide CFC campaigns are established and administered by the Director of the Office of Personnel Management (OPM) of the United States government. These contributions can be made either by cash or check or can be automatically deducted from participating federal employee's paychecks. As the Mountain State PCFO the Organization is responsible for the administration of the

Part XIII Supplemental Information *(continued)*

CFC for a thirty-five county area of West Virginia and acts as fiscal agent under the direction of the Local Federal Coordinating Committee. The OPM sets the requirements for PCFOs and requires that annual "agreed upon procedures" be performed by an independent Certified Public Accountant on the receipts and disbursements of the local CFC. Direct costs associated with the provision of this fiscal agent service are reimbursable along with allowable overhead costs, all of which are subject to budgetary constraints. The financial position and activities of the Mountain State Combined Federal Campaign are not included in these financial statements; however, the direct expenses incurred by the Organization operating as PCFO and the related reimbursements are in the accompanying statement of activities. The amount of direct expenses were \$23,553 and \$19,738 for the years ended December 2016, and 2015, respectively; whereas reimbursements amounted to \$19,738 for the year ended December 31, 2015. Further in accordance with the terms of this arrangement, the Organization maintains deposits in a local bank which represents amounts collected which have yet to be disbursed to applicable charitable organizations. At December 31, 2016 and 2015 this is reflected as a component of restricted cash in the accompanying statement of financial position in the amount of \$16,786 and \$14,379, respectively (See Note 5). Further, the custodial liability at December 31, 2016 and 2015 of \$17,846 and \$15,323, respectively in the accompanying statements of financial position reflects the Organization's obligation to disburse to these charitable organizations.

The Organization adopted Financial Accounting Standards Codification Topic "Accounting for Uncertainty in Income Taxes", which addresses the determination of whether tax benefits claimed or expected to be claimed on a tax return should be recorded in the financial statements. Under this guidance, the Organization may recognize the tax benefit from an uncertain tax position only if it is more-likely-than-not that the tax position will be sustained on examination by taxing authorities, based on the technical merits of the position. The tax benefits recognized in the financial statements from such a position are measured based on the largest benefit that has greater than 50% likelihood of being realized upon ultimate settlement. The Organization is generally no longer subject to examination by income taxing authorities for years ending prior to December 31, 2013.
